

# Prevention Ecosystem

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Prevention can be compared to a mangrove forest, where the forest itself reflects the interconnected efforts and shared vested interest of AANHPI and MENA communities. Survivors' lived expertise guides each step of the process.

## SUN

Strengthening knowledge and awareness about DV, SA, stalking, trafficking, and other forms of violence, and cultural strengths of AANHPI & MENA communities navigating these challenges

## AIR

Policy and systems-level advocacy: stories and practices are compiled and shared with hopes of safer conditions for all

## LEAVES

Events, workshops, story circles, and community gatherings that aim to educate and connect people

## FLOWERS AND SEEDS

Intergenerational transmission of practices for respect, communication, and safety

## BRANCHES

The networks and systems: community-based organizations, coalitions, and formal and informal community groups working to meet survivors' needs

## TRUNK

Community education as the key method of delivering prevention messaging

## ROOTS

Cultural context, including strengths and barriers for survivors

## WATER AND SOIL

Creating the conditions for collective safety and wellness across systems
